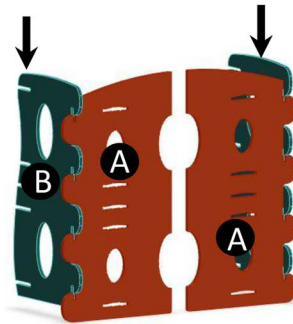
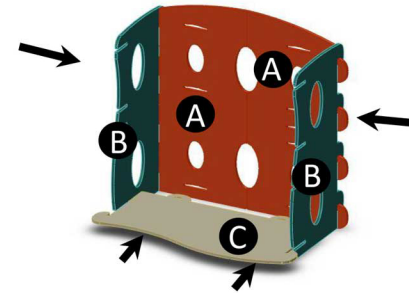


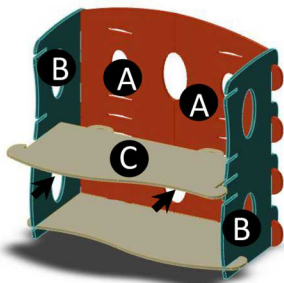
1. Find back panels (Fig. A).



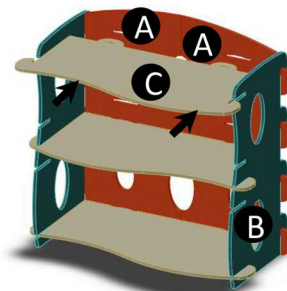
2. Slide one side panel (Fig. B) per back panel (Fig. A) to interlock on the corners. Every piece should slide easily into another piece. (Do not force, twist, or use tools to forcibly assemble or disassemble.)



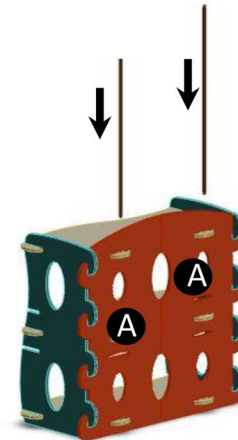
3. Insert one of the floor pieces (Fig. C) into back panels (Fig. A) and push two side panels (Fig. B) towards each other to lock in.



4. Slide another floor piece (Fig. C) into the back panels (Fig. A). This floor piece can be inserted into any of the three middle slots.



5. Slide the final floor piece (Fig. C) into the back panels (Fig. A).



7. Push dowel rods through holes in the tabs of the floor pieces (Fig. C), along the back side of the house.

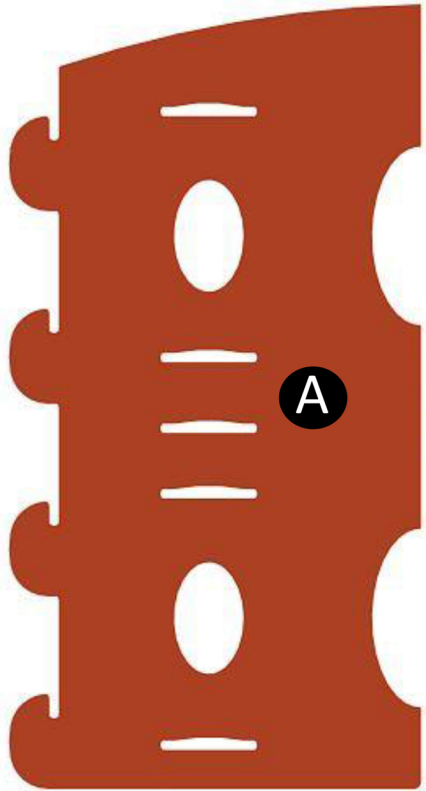
Assembly Notes:

\*Always push floor panels in equally on both sides simultaneously (not at angle).

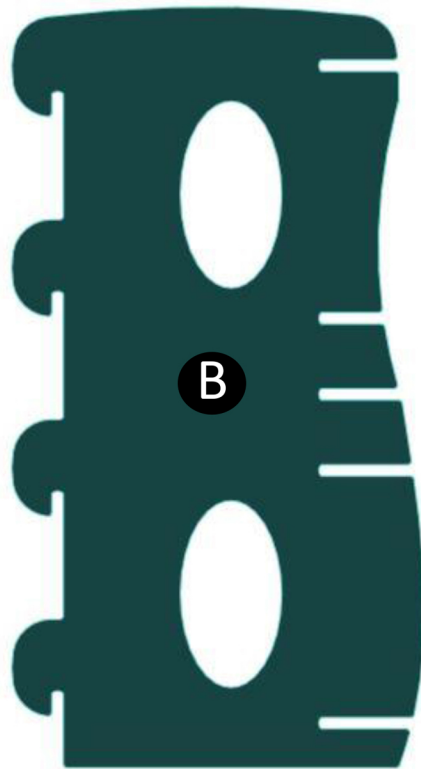
\*\* The floor pieces are symmetrical and can assemble in any orientation.



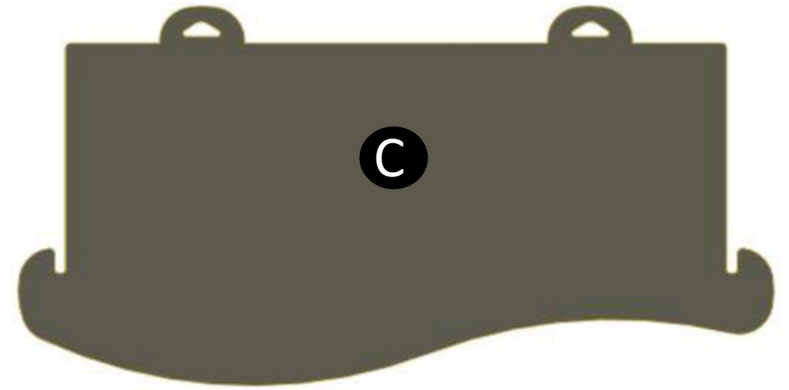
Adult assembly required. No human sitting, standing, or leaning on dollhouse components at any time (dolls only).
